October 15 – DEPART USA

Your pilgrimage begins as you depart the USA on your international overnight flight.

October 16 – ARRIVE IN ROME

You will arrive in Rome, Italy where you will be met by our representative and transferred to the Port of Civitavecchia to board the Explorer of the Seas. (D)

October 17 – TAORMINA, SICILY, ITALY

Explore Taormina, climb to the mountaintop Greek Theater with its spectacular views of the Mediterranean and Mt. Etna. Visit the Cathedral of Taormina, dedicated to St. Nicholas of Bari and celebrate Mass there. Enjoy a gelato while shopping or simply wander the streets with the occasional breathtaking view over the cliffs to the seaside below. (B,L,D)

October 18 - AT SEA

October 19 - CHANIA (SOUDA), CRETE, GREECE

Explore Crete on your own today or delve into a Cretan cultural experience by visiting Lake Kournas, the Arkadi Monastery or the bustling town of Rethymnon on an optional excursion. (B,L,D)

Shore excursions today will be booked directly through Royal Caribbean.

October 20 - MYKONOS

Arrive today at the world-famous Greek Island of Mykonos, where gleaming whitewashed buildings seem to climb atop each other to reach the azure sky. Admire its many hills dotted with iconic windmills. Explore the island on your own or join one of the optional excursions available for purchase on board. (B,L,D)

Shore excursions today will be booked directly through Royal Caribbean.

October 21 - ATHENS & CORINTH

Discover the rich architectural splendor of the ancient city of Athens as your guide introduces you to the world-renowned Acropolis, the Propylaea, the Parthenon and the Erechtheum. Stand on Mars Hill as the apostle Paul did when he proclaimed, “I found an altar with this inscription, TO THE UNKNOWN GOD. Whom therefore ye ignorantly worship, him declare I unto you”. As you stroll the Agora (ancient marketplace and center of Athenian public life), recall that this was where the Apostle Paul preached “Jesus and the resurrection”



to the skeptical Athenians. Also see the House of Parliament, the Presidential Palace and the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. This afternoon tour the city of Corinth, where the apostle Paul met fellow tentmakers, Aquila and Priscilla, and received a vision from the Lord saying, “I am with thee, and no man shall set on thee to hurt thee: for I have much people in this city.” As Paul spoke, Crispus (chief ruler of the synagogue) and many others believed and were baptized, establishing the church at Corinth to whom Paul later wrote his two epistles. Discover the Archaeological Museum, Market Place and Temples. As you walk among the ruins, stand on the Bema, where the apostle Paul stood before Gallio to face charges brought against him by the Jews. (B,L,D).

October 22 - SANTORINI

Dock in Santorini today, one of the most beautiful of the Greek islands where picturesque whitewashed villages topped with brilliant blue domes stand in stark contrast to the sheer drop cliffs overlooking the Aegean Sea. The island itself perches on the edges of a volcano whose eruption 3,500 years ago is thought to have led to the collapse of the Minoan civilization. Explore the island on your own or join one of the optional excursions available for purchase onboard. (B,L,D)

Shore excursions today will be booked directly through Royal Caribbean.

October 23 - AT SEA

October 24 – POMPEII

Journey inland to ancient Pompeii, dating almost to the time of Paul, where you can see the spectacular ruins that were covered by ash from the eruption of Mount Vesuvius in A.D. 79. Visit the Shrine of the Virgin of the Rosary of Pompeii to see the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary painting donated to Bartolo Longo while he was building the church. Celebrate Mass here before returning to the ship. (B,L,D)

October 25 – CATACOMBS, FOUNTAINS & SQUARES

Disembark the Explorer of the Seas this morning and transfer from Civitavecchia to Rome. We will drive along the Ancient Appian Way and visit the Catacombs. We will Celebrate Mass there. Afterwards, we will transfer to the city center. We will enjoy a walking tour to the Trevi fountain, explore the Pantheon, and end in Navona Square to enjoy free time for lunch and shopping. Check in to your hotel in Rome for dinner and overnight. (B,D)

October 26 – BASILICAS OF ROME & VATICAN MUSEUM

After breakfast, enjoy a tour of the Major Basilicas. The ceiling of the Basilica of St. Mary Major is said to be decorated with gold that Columbus brought back from the new world. We will also visit the Basilica of St. John Lateran which is the oldest of the major basilicas and ranks first as the actual “parish church” of the Pope. Enjoy a break for lunch on your own. After lunch, we will have a tour of the Vatican Museums, which house what can be described as the most important collections of art in the world, including the Sistine Chapel. Return to the hotel in Rome for dinner and overnight. (B,D)

October 27 – ASSISI

After breakfast, we will journey to Assisi to meet our local guide for a walking tour of the birthplace of St. Francis. We will visit the Basilicas

of St. Francis and St. Clare, and San Damiano Convent to see the Cross which spoke to St. Francis and Hermitage of Carceri. After lunch, we will visit St. Mary of the Angels in the Valley where we celebrate Mass and see the thornless rosebushes. Return to the hotel in Rome for dinner and overnight. (B,D)

October 28 – PAPAL AUDIENCE, IMPERIAL ROME, STEPS OF ST. PAUL

This morning we go to San Peter's square to attend the weekly papal audience. In the afternoon, we will have a panoramic tour of Roman antiquity. This includes Trajan's market, Trajan's Forum and Column, Arch of Constantine, and House of the Knights of Rhodes. Next, we proceed to the Colosseum. We continue to Tre Fontane Abbey, the place of Paul's martyrdom. Our last stop is at the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls. Celebrate Mass, then return to the hotel in Rome for dinner and overnight. (B,D)

October 29 – RETURN TO USA

Return home with a new understanding of the Apostle Paul's life and ministry. (B)

PAPAL AUDIENCE

The papal audience is scheduled for every Wednesday. In addition, His Holiness the Pope gives his blessing from the balcony of the Basilica every Sunday. We will ensure that you are present for this occasion. However, please be advised that due to the Pope's travel schedule, vacation or health, he may not be able to give his weekly audience or blessing.

CANCELLATION FEES:

From day of registration to 365 days prior you will not be charged a cancellation penalty. Additionally, thereafter, you will be charged any airline penalties and a single room supplement if your cancellation forces your roommate into a single plus the following charges: 364-241 days = \$100; 240-181 days = \$250; 180-151 days = \$500; 150-121 days = \$1,000; 120-91 days = 50% of total cost; 90-61 days = 75% of total cost; 60-day of departure = 100% of total cost. PASSPORT INFORMATION, CONFIRMATION OF ITINERARY & CHECK IN PROCESS:

Passport information must be submitted to our office by 06/17/20. Failure to provide your passport information to our office by this date may result in change fees or denial of travel. 120 days prior to your trip you will be contacted to re-confirm your itinerary, travel arrangements and registration information during the preliminary check in process for your trip. Discrepancies in information or failure to check in for your cruise may result in change fees, delays in receiving travel documents for your trip, or denial of travel.

PRICE INCREASES

All prices quoted in this brochure are subject to change prior to payment in full due to currency fluctuations, fuel surcharge increases, government taxes and fees increases or unforeseen circumstances.
