


Our Lady of Guadalupe

Mexico City, Puebla, Tlaxcala, Ocotlan, Teotihuacán, Xochimilco, Cuernavaca, Taxco



Day 1 - Depart U.S.A.

Arrive Mexico City airport where we will meet the tour guide and bus driver. Transfer to our hotel.

Day 2 - Shrine of Guadalupe - Mexico City

We will spend the day in Mexico City. Visit the impressive complex and one of Mexico's holiest shrines, "Our Lady of Guadalupe." Visit the New Basilica that houses the sacred image of the Virgin (Tilma), and the Old Basilica. Walk up Tepeyac Hill and the surrounding gardens. Then

enjoy a panoramic city tour that includes the Plaza of the Three Cultures, the Zocalo, the Metropolitan Cathedral and the National Palace.

Day 3 - Puebla - Tlaxcala - Our Lady of Ocotlan

After breakfast we depart to Puebla. We visit the Cathedral of Santo Domingo with the beautiful Dome of the Rosary Chapel, and Puebla's Cathedral dedicated to the Immaculate Conception. Later browse a little in the market place before continuing to Tlaxcala, and the Shrine of San Miguel del Milagro where St. Michael the Archangel appeared to Juan Diego Lazaro and told him of a miraculous spring. Continue to Ocotlan to visit the pilgrimage church and see the image of Our Lady where an apparition to Juan Diego in 1541 was miraculously burned into the trunk of an Oak Tree. Return to our hotel in Mexico City.



Day 4 - Mexico City - Teotihuacán - Xochimilco

This morning we drive to the neighborhoods of San Angel and Coyocacan with their colonial buildings, churches and lively public squares. Then we drive to Teotihuacán, one of the best-preserved ancient cities in Mexico. The mile-long Avenue of the Dead is framed by countless monumental structures, including the pyramids of the Sun and Moon. Today, we will also enjoy a visit to Xochimilco, the floating gardens.



Day 5 - Cuernavaca - Taxco

Depart Mexico City with a scenic drive to Cuernavaca, city of eternal springs. Here we will explore the market and the church area with its beautiful garden. Then travel to the famous silver mining town of Taxco, nestled in the rugged mountains of the Sierra Madre. We will stroll through the cobble-stone streets, visiting Santa Prisca Church with its Baroque altarpieces. Free time for shopping before returning to Mexico City.

Day 6 - Return to U.S.A.
