Prague, Vienna, Budapest & the Holy Land

August 27 - DEPART USA

Your pilgrimage begins as you depart the USA on an overnight flight.

August 28 - ARRIVE PRAGUE

Arrive at Prague International Airport and meet our professional Englishspeaking tour escort. Board the coach transfer to the hotel while enjoying the panoramic view of the city. Check in to the hotel upon arrival. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Prague.

August 29 - PRAGUE

Breakfast at the hotel. Enjoy a guided tour of Prague around the famous Castle District Hradcany. Then proceed to celebrate Mass at the Carmelite Father's Monastery chapel of our Lady of Victory. Free time for lunch on your own. After lunch we will cross the Charles Bridge to visit the Old Town, which is considered to be one of the best historical city centers in Europe. Visit the Old Town Square, the Town Hall with its famous Astronomical Clock which comes alive when the hour strikes and the twelve disciples appear to bless the crowd, as well as the Church of Our Lady Before Tyn. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Prague.

August 30 - PRAGUE / SVATÁ HORA / VIENNA

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out. Depart Prague to Vienna. Today we will drive to Svatá Hora, which is one of the most important places of pilgrimage in Central Europe. There are thousands of pilgrims coming there every year to venerate the Mother of God - the most precious local gem, which, according to legend, was carved from pear wood by Archbishop Arnost of Pardubice himself – one of the foremost counsellors in the court of Emperor Charles IV. Celebrate Mass at the Shrine. Continue on to Vienna. Lunch on your own en route. Check in to your hotel in Vienna for dinner and overnight.

August 31 - VIENNA

Breakfast at the hotel. Start the day with a visit to the Carmelite Cloister at the outskirts of Vienna where we can admire a miraculous picture of Our Lady of Bowed Head. Celebrate Holy Mass there. Meet our local guide and continue a guided tour of Vienna. The tour takes us to the impressive Gothic St. Stephen's Cathedral and then Ringstrasse with its magnificent buildings, such as State Opera House, the Museum of Fine Arts and the Museum of Natural History, the City Hall, the Hofburg Palace, the Parliament, the University and much more. Lunch on your own. Afternoon at leisure. Enjoy the time for shopping or just stroll around this magnificent city. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Vienna.

September 1 - VIENNA / BUDAPEST

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out. On the way to Budapest, visit the Former Pauline-Carmelite Monastery – Sopronbánfalva. For the Pauline monks, the town of Sopron founded a monastery in 1482 on the mountainside. From 1782, when Joseph II dismissed the Pauline order, it was used as officials' flats and the garrison hospital. From 1891 it became the convent of Carmelite nuns. After 1950 - with the dissolution of the Carmelite order – the building operated as a retirement home, then from the middle 1970s it was empty and abandoned. After 1989 it got back to the ownership of the Carmelites and in 2004 they sold it to Gabor Kovacs, founder of KOGART. Lunch on your own en route. Visit the Pannonhalma Abbey - Since its foundation in 996, it has majestically stood on a hilltop overlooking the plain. Its owes its birth to Géza, the first Magyar prince to be converted to Christianity. The abbey is still home to 70 monks, a secondary school and a theological institute. Upon arrival, check in to your hotel in Budapest for dinner and overnight.

September 2 - BUDAPEST

Breakfast at the hotel. Celebrate Mass in the Gellert Hill Cave Church. Enjoy a guided tour of Budapest to include the older section: Buda, located on the right bank of the Danube River where the Royal Castle, the Matyas Church and the Fisherman's Bastion can be found. Lunch on your own. Continue the guided tour on the other bank of the Danube river and see one of the most outstanding buildings in Europe- the Neo-Gothic Parliament, as well as Hero's Square and the Church of St. Stephen. Enjoy the rest of the afternoon



at leisure. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Budapest.

September 3 - BUDAPEST DEPARTURE

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out. Transfer to the airport for your flight to Israel. Upon arriving in Israel, we will stay for four nights at the Carmelite Monastery of Stella Maris in Haifa.

September 4 - ALL DAY IN HAIFA

Today we will enjoy a day tour to Haifa and visit Mount Carmel to see the Cave of the Prophet Elijah. We will also visit El-Muhraka, the place where the prophet challenged the priests of Baal.

September 5 - CANA AND MOUNT TABOR

In Nazareth, we visit the Church of the Annunciation that stands over the cave that tradition holds to be the home of the Virgin Mary. We then stop in Cana and visit the Church where Jesus performed His first public miracle at the wedding. We celebrate Mass and renew our wedding vows. We will then drive up to Mount Tabor to visit the Church and the Monastery of the Transfiguration.

September 6 - SEA OF GALILEE / CAPERNAUM / MOUNT OF BEATITUDES / BOAT RIDE

We will visit the sites around the Sea of Galilee, the ancient Roman city of Caesarea Philippi, Mount of Beatitudes, Capernaum, St. Peter's Primacy and Bethsaida where we do an anointing of the sick. Enjoy a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee.

September 7 - CAESAREA / OLD JAFFA / JERUSALEM

On our way to Jerusalem, we stop in Caesarea to view the ruins of the old Roman city and the aqueduct. In Tel Aviv, we will visit Old Jaffa and the Church of St. Peter. On to Jerusalem for overnight.

September 8 - MOUNT OF OLIVES / GETHSEMANE / BETHLEHEM / EIN KAREM

We start our day with the Mount of Olives, the Church of Pater Noster and the Chapel of the Ascension and down to Dominus Flevit and St. Mary Magdalene Church. Pray at the Garden of Gethsemane and visit the Church of All Nations. On to Bethlehem to visit the Church of the Nativity, the Basilica of St. Catherine, and the Shepherds' Field. Visit the Milk Grotto and in the afternoon return to Jerusalem, stopping en route in Ein Karem to visit the Church of the Visitation.

September 9 - OLD CITY OF JERUSALEM / MOUNT ZION

Early morning transfer to the Old City to have our own procession of the "Way of the Cross" ending with Mass at the Church of the Holy Sepulcher. After Mass, we return to our hotel for breakfast. Later, we start our walking tour of the Old City by visiting the Church of St. Anne, the Pools of Bethesda, Ecce Homo, and walk through the Cardo to the Wailing Wall. On Mount Zion, we visit the Upper Room and the Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu.
