ITINERARY

Praising the Lord as we travel the world...

October 11 - Depart the USA

Depart Los Angeles on AZ2235 at 6:30am. Arrive Philadelphia at 2:50pm. Depart Philadelphia on AA258 at 9:15pm.

October 12 - Lisbon, Fatima

We will arrive in Lisbon at 9:05am. Meet the tour escort and enjoy a panoramic tour of the city. Tour includes the most important sites of the city such as the Lisbon Cathedral and Church of St. Anthony. The church is located in the Alfama region of the city where St. Anthony was born and grew up. St. Anthony (*better known as Saint Anthony of Padua*) is revered as a matchmaker, protector of young brides, and patron of the lost and found. Then, we will continue our panoramic tour to see *St. Jerome's Monastery, the Belem Tower*, and Discoveries Monument. Continue to Fatima for dinner and overnight.

October 13 - Fatima

Today, we will visit the *Chapel of the Apparitions, the Basilica and the tombs of Francisco, Jacinta and Sr. Lucia.* We visit also the Monument to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. In Aljustrel and Valinhos, we see the two homes of the little shepherds and site of the first and third visit of the *"Angel of Peace"*. We stop at the Parish Church and the cemetery where Francisco and Jacinta were once buried. We have dinner and join the nightly candlelight procession.

October 14 - Fatima, Santiago De Compostela

This morning, we will depart our hotel and drive to *Santiago De Compostela*. Upon arrival, we will visit the magnificent *Cathedral of St.James*, formed by Galician granite. This Cathedral is one of the finest architectural examples in Europe as it encompasses Romanesque, Gothic and Baroque styles. The Cathedral contains numerous, valuable pieces of art. It is traditional to hug the statue of St. James upon entering the Cathedral. *Our private guided walking tour takes us into the crypt where the relics of the Patron Saint* of Pilgrims are kept. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

October 15 - Santiago, Burgos

Today, we will depart for Burgos which is *home of El Cid*. We will tour the Cathedral, Spain's third largest. After hotel checkin, we will rest and enjoy time at leisure. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

October 16 - Burgos, Lourdes

After breakfast, we will drive to Loyola to visit the *Shrine of St. Ignacio of Loyola* and continue to Lourdes for dinner and overnight.

October 17 - Lourdes

This morning, we will visit the historical and spiritual sites associated with the visionary child Bernadette. Visit the *Grotto of the Apparitions*, and then continue on a guided walking tour visiting the Basilica of St. Piux X, Bolly Mill, Soubirous family home, *the Basilica of the Rosary, the miraculous spring, and the bealing baths*. After dinner, we will join the nightly rosary and candlelight procession.

October 18 - Lourdes, Montserrat, Barcelona

Today, we will depart Lourdes and drive to *Montserrat*, where we will stop to visit the Monastery and celebrate mass. Continue to Barcelona for dinner and overnight at the hotel.

October 19 - Barcelona

After breakfast, we will enjoy a panoramic tour of the city including which includes the most important sites of Barcelona such as the *Sagrada Familia (inside)*, *Paseig de Gracia*, *Plaza Catalunya*, *Montjuic*, *Barrio Gotico with Barcelona's Cathedral*. Free time for shopping Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

October 20 - Barcelona, Rome, Cascia, Assisi

Very early morning check out. Then we drive the airport and depart on a domestic flight to Rome. Upon arrival, *we transfer to Cascia, where we will visit the monastery where Santa Rita lived as a nun and where she died.* Continue to Assisi , check in at the hotel dinner and overnight.

October 21 - Assisi

After breakfast our walking guided tour departs from Santa Chiara Church that honors *St. Clare, the foundress of the Poor*

Clare Sisters. This Saint followed the teachings of St. Francis very closely by also living a life of poverty and humility. By walk we reach the Santuario Della Spogliazione where Blessed Carlo Acutis' tomb is placed. Carlo is the first millennial to be declared Blessed who loved the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. From there, we will continue on a walking tour through this picturesque town, including the *birthplace of St. Francis*, and finally we will visit St. Francis Basilica. In the upper basilica, we will marvel at the site of the great frescoes from Giotto, which describes the life of St Francis de Assisi in the lower basilica we visit the tomb of St. Francis. Celebrate mass and then continue to Oriveto/Bolsena and visit St. Christiana Church where the Eucharistic *Mircale took place*. Return to the hotel in Assisi for dinner and an overnight.

October 22 - Assisi, Rome, Saint Paul Outside The Walls, Vatican Museums, San Peter's Basilica

After breakfast we check out and depart to Rome. Upon arrival, we celebrate Mass at the *Basilica of Saint Paul* Outside the walls. Continue to the Vatican. Time at leisure for lunch. This afternoon we will visit the *Vatican Museums and the Sistine Chapel*. Continue to visit *St. Peter's Basilica*, built on the site where St. Peter was martyred. Known as the grandest of the world's churches, St. Peter's is unsurpassed in beauty. Continue to the hotel for check in, dinner and overnight.

October 23 - Papal Audience, Basilicas – Trevi Fountain

This morning, we'll return to the Vatican, to join thousands of pilgrims from all over the world, for the **Papal Audience and Blessing.** After break for lunch, transfer to the city centre to visit the other major basilicas. The Basilica of St. John Lateran which is the oldest of the major basilicas and ranks first as the actual "parish church" of the Pope (Bishop of Rome). There we will learn about the Scala Santa (Holy Stairs). Tradition has it that these steps, said to be the staircase leading once to the praetorium of *Pilate at* Jerusalem, are sanctified by the footsteps of Jesus Christ during his Passion- The ceiling of the Basilica of St. Mary Major is said

to be decorated with gold that Columbus brought back from the new world. This basilica, the largest in Rome dedicated to the Blessed Mother, is part of the day's "Christian Rome" tour, and has beautiful Biblical mosaics, a marble floor, *bell tower and one of the oldest sbrines (containing a relic from the manger of the infant Jesus) dedicated to the Blessed Virgin.* We stop by the Basilica of the Holy Cross and the Roman Coliseum. Before returning to the hotel, we will enjoy a short walk to the *Spanish Steps and Trevi Fountain.* Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

October 24, 2024 - Rome, San Giovanni Rotondo

This morning we depart Rome and drive approx 6 hours towards south. We reach San Giovanni Rotondo and check in at our hotel. This afternoon is dedicated to *Saint* Padre Pio. We honor his work as we visit his tomb, his cell, his confessional and the Capuchin Monastery of Our Lady of Grace, where we celebrate Mass. We will also visit the new Church of *Santa Maria* **Delle Grazie**, and the Home for the Relief of the Suffering- With our guide we will visit the shrine to see the crucifix where St. Pio received the stigmata and visit the confessional where he spent innumerable hours listening to confessions. Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

October 25 - San Giovanni Rotondo, San Michael's Cave, Rome

After breakfast we check out. Next, we board our bus and travel along the beautiful Gargano Peninsula to the Grotto of *St. Michael the Archangel, a shrine consecrated by St. Michael*, who appeared to a Bishop at this grotto to assure him that his diocese would not be annihilated as he feared. Following our visit to the grotto, we have time to explore independently. After lunch, on the way back, we enjoy the breathtaking ocean and surrounding countryside views. Tonight, we will overnight near Rome, to be closer to the airport. Dinner at the hotel and overnight.

October 26 - Return to the USA

Depart Rome on AA111 at 11:05am. Arrive Chicago at 2:55pm. Depart Chicago on AA2364 at 4:50pm. Arrive Los Angeles at 7:03pm.
