Day 1 - Saturday, September 28

Departure

Depart on an overnight flight LH451 from Los Angeles at 3:15pm. Dinner and breakfast are served on the flight.

Day 2 - Sunday, September 29

Malta

Arrive in Frankfurt at 2:50pm. Depart Frankfurt on LH1312 at 8:40pm and arrive in Malta at 11:25pm. We will meet our English-speaking tour guide and check into our hotel. We will have a light dinner (probably sandwiches and fruit) and overnight stay.

Day 3 - Monday, September 30

St. Paul In Malta: Rabat & Mdina

This morning, we will depart our hotel and head to Rabat, where we will celebrate Mass and visit St. Paul's Church and Grotto, a church founded over the ancient caves where he was held captive. We will also visit the earliest archaeological evidence of Christianity, the Catacombs of St. Paul. Lunch is included in Mdina, the highest elevation of Malta, where we will see

stunning views of the entire island. After our free time in Mdina, we will visit the cathedral dedicated to St. Peter and St. Paul. We will proceed to Mosta and visit the Mosta Rotunda, a magnificent domed church, and return to our hotel to relax. Tonight, we will enjoy a special restaurant dinner accompanied by music and a folklore show.

Day 4 - Tuesday, October 1 Malta, Valetta

Upon arrival in Valetta this morning, we will visit the tombs at St. John's Co-Cathedral, Barracca Gardens, and St. Paul's Church, where we will see a relic of the saint's hand and celebrate Mass. Free time in Valletta for lunch on our own and shopping. We will return to our hotel and relax before dinner. Dinner and overnight will be at our hotel.

Day 5 - Wednesday, October 2 Malta, Rome, Assisi

We will check out of our hotel early this morning, head to the airport, and fly to Rome. Upon arrival, we drive to Cascia. After lunch, we will visit the monastery, where St. Rita lived as a nun. Then, we will visit the basilica, which houses the incorrupt body of St Rita. Here, we will celebrate Mass. Then, we will continue to Assisi. Check-in at the hotel for your dinner and overnight stay.

Day 6 - Thursday, October 3 **Assisi**

After breakfast, we will enjoy a walking guided tour of the birthplace of St. Francis. We will start from Santa Chiara Church, which honors St. Clare, the foundress of the Poor Clare Sisters. This saint followed the teachings of St. Francis very closely by also living a life of poverty and humility. By walking, we will reach the Santuario Della Spogliazione, where Blessed Carlo Acutis' tomb is placed. Carlo is the first millennial to be declared blessed, and loved Jesus's real presence in the Eucharist. From there, we will continue a walking tour through this picturesque town and finally, we will visit St. Francis Basilica. In the upper basilica, we will marvel at the site of the great frescoes from Giotto, which describe the life of St. Francis. In the lower basilica, we will visit the tomb of St. Francis. Celebrate Mass. The balance of the day is at leisure. Return to the hotel for dinner and an overnight stay.

Day 7 - Friday, October 4 Assisi, Pompei, Sorrento

We will depart the hotel and drive to Pompei (a 5-hour drive) after breakfast. After break for our lunch, we will meet the local guide and enjoy a walking tour to the Scavi, the "frozen city" of Pompei. Then, we will visit the Shrine of Our Lady of the Rosary and celebrate Mass. Continue to Sorrento. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

Day 8 - Saturday, October 5

Amalfi Coast

Today, we will enjoy the Amalfi Coast! From our hotel, by minivans, we will drive along the scenic "Amalfi Coast." We will stop in Positano, the Pearl of the Amalfi Coast. Then we will continue by boat to Amalfi to enjoy a delicious lunch (NOT INCLUDED). In the early afternoon, discover Amalfi, one of the pearls of the Mediterranean Sea. We will marvel at the colors of the beautiful streets, rich in history and art, famous worldwide, and, since 1997, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Enjoy free time to experience tasting typical products such as fresh homemade lemonade, slices of sugary lemon, lemon, and orange jams, and limoncello. Return to Sorrento by minibus. Dinner and overnight at our hotel.

Day 9 - Sunday, October 6 Sorrento, Capri, Sorrento

We will board the hydrofoil to Capri (9:40 AM). Upon arrival, we will reach the top of Capri by cable car and discover the picturesque village and the marvelous sparkling sea from above with a local guide. After lunch, we will enjoy our leisure time shopping. In the afternoon, we will board the hydrofoil back to Sorrento (4:00 PM). Dinner and overnight at our hotel.

Day 10 - Monday, October 7

Return to the USA

Early this morning, we are transferred to the Naples airport for our flight home. Depart on LH337 at 6:40am and arrive in Frankfurt at 8:50am. Depart Frankfurt on LH456 at 10:30am and arrive in Los Angeles at 1:00pm.
