Monday, October 7, 2024

Depart Honolulu

Depart on flight AA144 at 10:41 PM to Los Angeles.

Tuesday, October 8, 2024

Los Angeles, Lisbon

Arrive LAX at 7:14 AM and transfer on flight AA1612 at 9:20 AM to Philadelphia, arriving at 5:50 PM. Transfer on flight AA2580 at 9:15 PM to Lisbon.

Wednesday, October 9, 2024

Arrive Lisbon, Fatima

Arrive at the Lisbon Airport at 9:05 AM. We will meet our tour guide and driver. Then, we will enjoy a panoramic city tour, including St. Geronimo's Monastery (from the outside), the Belem Tower, and the Basilica of St. Anthony of Padua. Here, we will celebrate Mass. In the afternoon, we will continue to Fatima.

Thursday, October 10, 2024

Fatima

Today, we will spend the day in Fatima. After celebrating Mass, we will visit the Chapel of the Apparitions, the basilica, and the tombs of Francisco, Jacinta, and Sr. Lucia. We will also visit the Monument to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. In Aljustrel and Valinhos, we will see the two homes of the little shepherds and the site of the first and third visit of the "Angel of Peace." Finally, we will stop at the Parish Church and the cemetery where Francisco and Jacinta were once buried. We will have a free afternoon for personal activities. After dinner, we will join the nightly candlelight procession.

Friday, October 11, 2024

Fatima, Santiago De Compostela

This morning, we will depart Fatima and drive to Santiago de Compostela. Upon arrival, we will visit the magnificent Cathedral

of St. James. Formed of Galician granite, this cathedral is one of the finest architectural examples in Europe as it encompasses Romanesque, Gothic, and Baroque styles. The cathedral contains numerous valuable pieces of art that truly captivate the eye. It is traditional to hug the statue of St. James upon entering the cathedral. Our private guided walking tour takes us into the crypt where the Patron Saint of Pilgrims' relics are kept. We will celebrate Mass in a local church after the tour.

Saturday, October 12, 2024

Santiago De Compostela, Oviedo, San Sebastian

Today, we will drive to Oviedo, the capital of Asturias region. We will visit the cathedral, which houses the tombs of Asturian kings, and the Camara Santa, a restored 9th-century chapel containing expressive statues of Christ and the Apostles. Here, we will celebrate Mass. In the afternoon, we will continue to San Sabastian.

Sunday, October 13, 2024

San Sebastian, Loyola, Lourdes

This morning, we will continue our journey to Lourdes. En route, we will stop in Loyola to visit the birthplace of St. Ignatius, founder of the Jesuit Order. He dedicated himself to becoming a soldier of the Christian faith, and he wrote the ever-famous Spiritual Exercises. In Loyola, we will see the 17th-century basilica dedicated to this remarkable saint. We can also pray in the most venerated room, where St. Ignatius begged and began his conversion. Here, we will celebrate Mass. Continue to Lourdes.

Monday, October 14, 2024

Lourdes

Today, we will spend the day in Lourdes. We will visit the historical and spiritual

sites associated with the visionary child Bernadette. We begin at the Grotto of the Apparitions and then continue a guided walking tour, visiting the Basilica of St. Pius X, Boly Mill, the Soubirous family home, the Basilica of the Rosary, the miraculous spring, and the healing baths. Celebrate Mass. After dinner, we will join in the nightly rosary and candlelight procession.

Tuesday, October 15, 2024

Bordeaux, Naples

Today, we will depart to Bordeaux. From here, we will depart at 2:05 PM on a Volotea flight to Naples. Upon arrival, at 04:20 pm, we will continue to San Giovanni Rotondo.

Wednesday, October 16, 2024

San Giovanni Rotondo, San Michael's Cave,

Our day begins with a tour of Casa Sollievo della Sofferenza, the hospital founded by Padre Pio. Then, we will return to Santa Maria delle Grazie to visit the church and confessional, where Padre Pio committed to hours of listening to confession as he was incredibly devoted to the sacrament. It was said that he could read souls, and pilgrims have long been known to leave tiny papers with intentions near his confessional. At this shrine, we will also see the incorrupt body of this great saint, along with his living quarters. After lunch, we will drive along the beautiful Gargano Peninsula to Monte Sant'Angelo (grotto of St. Michael), where St. Michael is said to have appeared. We will celebrate Mass in the cave.

Thursday, October 17, 2024

Santa Philomena, Frascati

This morning, we will depart to Mugnano del Cardinale. Upon arrival, we will visit the shrine dedicated to Santa Philomena. Celebrate Mass, visit the museum, and continue towards Rome.

Friday, October 18, 2024

Rome's Major Basilicas

Today, we will begin our day by celebrating Mass at the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls. Continue to the other basilicas of Rome. Basilica of St Mary Major, built by Pope Sixtus III (AD 432-440). View the impressive interior with its remarkable mosaics in the nave depicting scenes from the Old Testament. View relics of Jesus' manger from Bethlehem and the high altar, which contains the remains of St. Matthew

the Evangelist. The mosaics above the entablature are among Rome's most ancient Christian mosaics. After lunch, we will visit the Basilica of the Holy Cross of Jerusalem to see the relics of the Passion Christi. Continue to the Holy Stairs and the Basilica of St. John Lateran, the first Christian church to be consecrated. Emperor Constantine founded it in the 4th-century, and it was home to the popes for many years before the present Vatican residence. Our day ends as we make a stop at stop at the Colosseum to take a picture.

Saturday, October 19, 2024

Vatican Museums, San Giovanni Rotondo

This morning, we will visit the Vatican Museums, which house what can be described as the world's most important collections of art. Highlights include The Tapestry Gallery, The Raphael Rooms, and The Sistine Chapel, where we will gaze at Michelangelo's incredible masterpiece. The tour continues in St. Peter's Basilica. Here, we will find Michelangelo's magnificent "Pieta." Pray at the new tomb of Blessed John Paul II in St. Sebastian's Chapel. After lunch, we will walk to Castel Sant'Angelo and Navona Square. We will visit the Church of Sant Augustin, where his mother, Santa Monica, is buried, and where we can admire Caravaggio's masterpiece "Madonna de' Pellegrini".

Sunday, October 20, 2024

Papal Audience & Imperial Rome with Spanish Steps and Trevi Fountain

This morning, we will transfer to the Vatican City to join pilgrims worldwide for an audience with His Holiness the Pope (subject to the Holy Father's schedule and health). After lunch, we will enjoy a walking tour from the Colosseum (visit from outside) and pass by the Roman Forum, Traian Forum, and the column to Capitol Hill and Venice Square. Continue to the Trevi Fountain, where we throw a coin and promise to be back to Rome, then to the Spanish Step.

Monday, October 21, 2024

Departure

Depart on flight AA2390 at 10:10 AM to Dallas, arriving at 2:50 P.M. Transfer on flight AA1669 at 4:35 PM to Los Angeles, arriving at 5:45 PM. Transfer on flight AA2970 at 6:22 PM to Honolulu, arriving at 9:00 PM.
